BANTAM-JUNIOR COVID-19 POLICY AND PROTOCOLS

BRANT CURLING COVID-19 POLICY

For the 2021-22 season, every curler in the bantam-junior curling program, and anyone who accompanies them into the club, will be required to have received two doses of Health Canada approved Covid vaccine (any combination of two vaccines is acceptable) at least 14 days prior to their first attendance with the exception of those under 12 years of age. Accommodation for people who cannot be vaccinated because of medical condition, disability, religious conviction and/or age will be considered and will include mandatory masking and/or regularly submitting negative Covid tests.

The Club will require proof of vaccination status prior to the beginning of the regular curling season. This information will be viewed by Club Office Staff and the Club President only. Vaccination verification and exemption processes will be developed by a subcommittee of the Board and details about that process will be provided in the near future.

BANTAM JUNIOR SUNDAY CURLING COVID-19 PROTOCOLS

GENERAL

- Follow the recommended COVID procedures of wearing a mask (covering the nose mouth and chin), social distancing and hand washing. Avoid touching your nose, eyes or mouth. Sneeze into your arm.
- ➤ If anyone in your household is experiencing symptoms of COVID, is under quarantine as ordered by the Brant County Heath Unit or has tested positive for COVID in the past two weeks, then please do not attend Sunday curling.

ARRIVAL

- You may enter the building beginning at 1:45 pm, 15 minutes prior to the start of curling. Masks must be on prior to entering the building. Use the hand sanitizer once you have entered the building.
- > Outer footwear is to be stored on the shoe racks near the entrance. Please maintain social distancing.
- Register your presence and your curler's presence for the purposes of contact tracing.

CURLING

- While in the lounge area, masks are to be worn at all times. Please socially distance while in the lounge.
- > It is recommended that curlers have their own water bottle and hand sanitizer.
- On the ice surface, the wearing of masks for bantam-junior curlers is required.
- Instructors will be wearing masks at all times.

Your cooperation in keeping everyone safe is greatly appreciated.

DEPARTURE

- > Please maintain social distancing. Masks must be worn until you have exited the building.
- > After putting on your outdoor shoes, please use the hand sanitizer as you exit the building.

The main objective of the Policy and Protocols is to stay safe and healthy during the curling season. With the curlers attending school, we do not want to be the location of the transmission of COVID. The policy and protocols will be revised during the season as recommended policies change.
